Sexual and Reproductive Health: Breaking Stigmas, Building Futures

As a national delegate, it will be your goal to understand your nation's current policies and reproductive-health-related health issues that your nation is facing in order to write a resolution alongside other countries. Part of the assignment is a position paper, which is a brief research essay outlining your nation's policies and opinions.

Guiding questions for your position paper may include, but aren't limited to:

- Which of the four subthemes is most important to your country (sexual and repro health education, reproductive rights, domestic violence and sexual assault, or queer health)?
- Has your country had any recent events that would affect the state of sexual and reproductive health?
- What policies already exist in your country surrounding sexual and reproductive health?
- What policies exist in similar countries that you could aim to implement?
- What is your country's relationship with neighboring countries?

Please format your position paper in Times New Roman, 12 point font, single spaced. The position paper should be one to two pages long. The heading should include your name, your country's name, and your regional office (AMRO, AFRO, EURO/EMRO, or WPRO/SEARO).

The position paper is not for credit and will not affect your ability to attend the AMWHO conference. However, it is highly encouraged that you research the state of food insecurity in your nation ahead of time in order to make the most of your conference experience. You will also have the chance to win "best position paper" or "best delegation" for your region.
