3 4 5	<i>Convinced</i> that the global community has a role in confining conflict and resolving potential epidemics,
6 7 8	<i>Recognizing</i> that acute conflict and disease outbreak are difficult to prepare for financially and in human capital,
9	Bearing in mind that extreme incidences are inevitable and pose a risk to vulnerable
10	populations including but not limited to children, refugees, the elderly, minorities and those
11 12	undergoing treatment for non-communicable disease,
13	Commending the efforts by the WHO State Members that have contributed to capacity
14 15	building,
16	Confident that these efforts will help to reduce the degradation of health infrastructure in
17	times of conflict,

20	1. Urges conflict stricken nations to focus to emergency management tactics, including but
21 22	not limited to the provision of vaccinations, clean water, food security and refugee camps;
23	2. <i>Endorses</i> the creation of emergency management tactics, including but not limited to
24 25	vaccinations, clean water, food security, refugee, mental health;
26	3. Strongly affirms that regional members allocate three percent of annual World Health
27 28	Organization dues to contribute to emergency relief funding for five years and one percent of annual World Health Organization dues for a following seven years;

30	4. <i>Hopes</i> to establish an endowment with the yearly contribution allocated to the Emergency
31 32	Relief Fund;
33	5. Calls upon governments to develop such strategies for disaster preparedness and
34 35	collaborate with the regional office Emergency Disaster Relief Fund;
36	6. Further recommends governments seek foreign aid and non-governmental organization aid
37 38	to first contribute to disaster and conflict response;
39	7. <i>Trusts</i> governments to apply for Emergency Funds with the understanding that access is
40 41	granted based on contribution;

- 42 8. *Designates* the containment and initial conflict response in accordance to emergency
- 43 severity index;

- 45 9. *Requests* that non contributing members to the Resolution: Sustained Human Resource
- 46 Strengthening and Capacity Building Focused on Disaster Management exhaust all other
- 47 funding opportunities before applying for the Emergency Relief Funds.

- 49 10. *Encourages* government to spend resources to strengthen human resources for health
- 50 and health workforce capacity.
